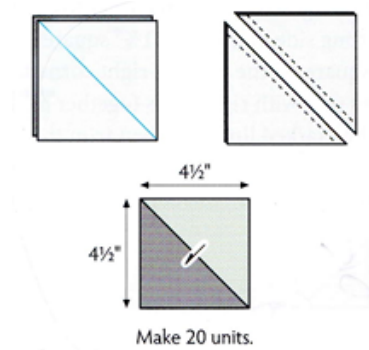
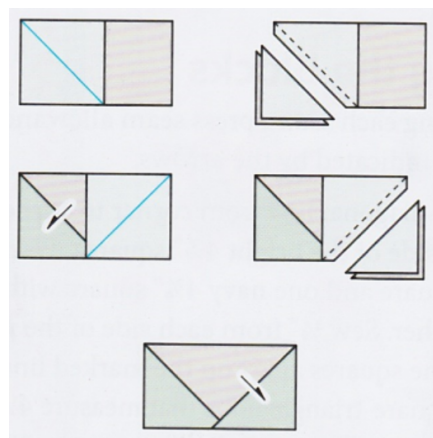


Making the Blocks (press seams in direction of arrows)

1. Draw diagonal line from corner to corner on wrong side of 10 bright 5" x 5" squares.
Place one bright square and one navy/dark square with right sides together.
Sew ¼" from each side of the drawn line.
Cut on the drawn line, making 2 half square triangles.
Iron seam allowance towards dark fabric.
Square up to 4½" x 4½".
Make 20 square units.



2. Flying Geese: Draw diagonal line from corner to corner on wrong side of two matching bright 2½" squares.
Place one square on white/light 2½" x 4½" rectangle, with drawn line as shown below.
Sew on marked line, then trim ¼" seam allowance.
Repeat with second marked bright square as shown. Make 4 units
Square up to 2½" x 4½".

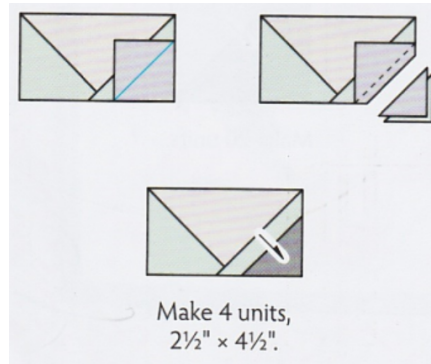


3. Draw diagonal line from corner to corner on wrong side of **navy/dark** 1¾" squares.

Place the dark square on the bottom right-hand corner of the Flying Geese with right sides together.

Sew on the drawn line. Trim seam to allowance ¼".

Make 4 units 2½" x 4½".



NOTE: Make sure the dark fabric is in the same corner of each Flying Geese.

Center Block Assembly – 8½" x 8½"

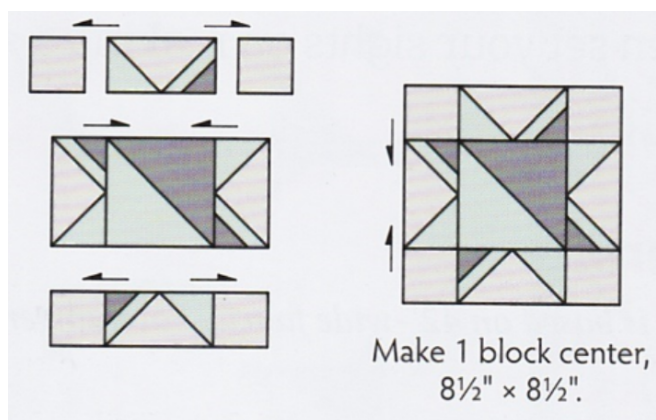
Lay out:

Four 2½" light/white squares.

Four matching Flying Geese.

Half square triangle unit.

Sew together and iron seams as shown below.



Dancing Stars Block Assembly – $11\frac{1}{2}" \times 11\frac{1}{2}"$

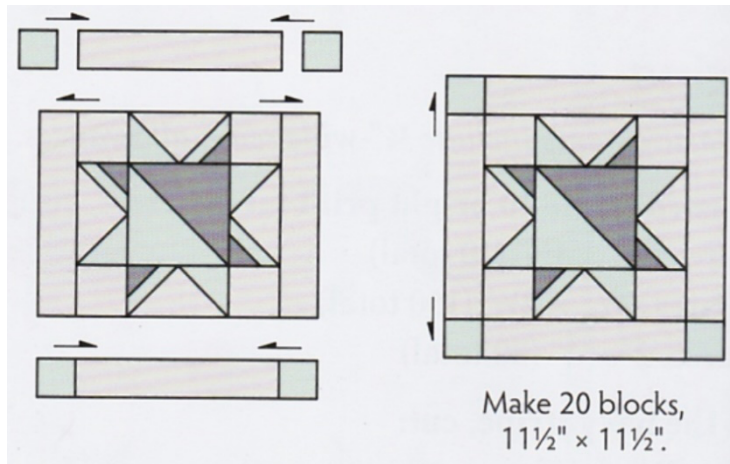
Lay out:

Center block assembly

Four 2" bright squares

Four 2" x $8\frac{1}{2}"$ white/light rectangles

Make 20 blocks. Sew together and iron seams as shown below.



Assembling Quilt Top

Arrange five (5) rows of four (4) blocks, rotating blocks so the Stars are dancing as shown in figure below.

Sew and iron seams as shown below.

Quilt center should measure $44\frac{1}{2}" \times 55\frac{1}{2}"$ without any borders.
